

Thursday Night Putting League at What's On Tap

The rules provided below are intended to be general guidelines for the Upstate Disc Golf Club's Thursday Putting League. The club officers and the tournament director (TD) reserve the right to modify, add, delete, or alter this document as necessary.

1. SCHEDULE

The Club will host a singles putting league on Thursday nights at What's On Tap.

Players must sign in between 6:30 and 7:30.

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Regardless of skill level, anyone is welcome to play provided they are at least thirteen (13) years of age.

3. ENTRY FEE

\$5 for Upstate Club Members and \$6 for non-members.

4. FORMAT & RULES OF PLAY

- Each week consists of 3 rounds.
- Each round consists of 5 putts from each of the 3 stations (15 putts per round).
- Putts at each station are worth a different number of points as shown below.

Station 1	Station 2	Station 3
5 putts from 20'	5 putts from 25'	5 putts from 30'
1 pt each	2 pts each	3 pts each

- You are not required to play stations in order, but all 3 stations must be completed before you begin the next round.
- Your night's final score for those in the Pro division will be the average score of all three of your rounds. For those in the Am division, your final score will be the average of your best two rounds.

- You will be classified as a Pro if the average of your scores for the last 3 weeks (attended) is in the top 20% of players participating that night. Players with no handicap will be considered Am unless they request otherwise.
- Use the paper scorecard provided and turn into the TD upon completion.

5. SCORECARDS

Each player is responsible for ensuring their first and last name is on their scorecard and that it is accurate, complete, and turned in to the TD by 8:30.

6. CONDUCT

If a player breaks the following rules, the club, TD, and/or What's On Tap reserves the right to suspend or ban the player from the league:

- No cheating
- Conduct yourself with good sportsmanship at all times
- Be courteous to other players as well as other bar patrons
- Do not deface or damage bar or club property

7. PAYOUTS, PRIZES, & PLAY-OFFS

- Top performers each night will be awarded cash payout. The number of places paid (and the amount each place is paid) will be determined by the total players in attendance that week. Five (5) dollars of every fee goes towards the night's payout. The remaining one (1) of non-members fees covers administrative costs and other prizes.
- All payouts must be claimed the night awarded. If players leave without claiming winnings, they must designate another player to claim any winnings. The TD/club are not responsible for unclaimed winnings.
- Ties for first place will be broken with a single lightning round (3 putts per station). All other ties will remain.

8. INCOMPLETE ROUNDS

If you quit before completing all rounds, you will receive zero points for all unfinished stations/rounds. No refunds will be given.
